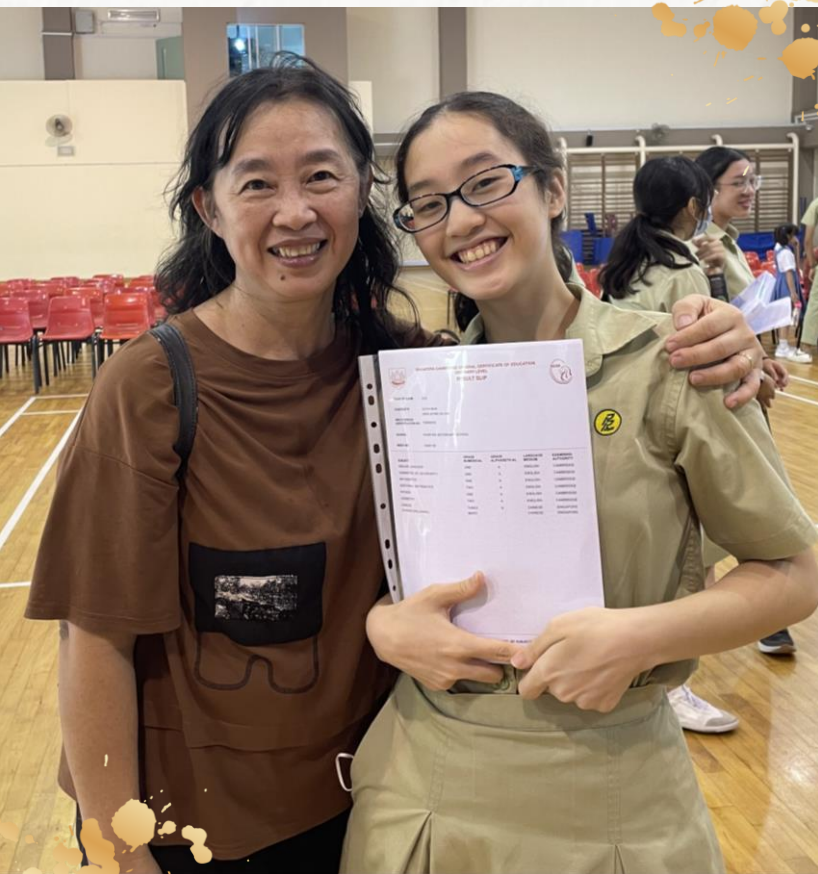
Grace Poh / 4E5 / 5A1s, 3A2s / CCA: Choir
