#### **Holistic Development Activities**

In Term 4, the school will continue to organize activities that cater to

# **Support for Graduating Classes**

The Post-Prelim Programme (PPP) is conducted for the graduating

Following the PPP, graduating classes will also go on a short study break to consolidate their learning before sitting for the national exams.
