CCA Achievements

CCAs are conduits for our students to discover their interests and strengths beyond the academics, and to develop holistically. Key traits such as leadership, student agency and resilience are honed through communal learning experiences in CCAs. Pasirians have done exceptionally well in CCAs in 2023 as they revert to pre-Covid norms.

Chinese Orchestra, Choir, Concert Band, English Drama obtained the Certificate of Distinction in the Singapore Youth Festival while Modern Dance was accorded the Certificate of Accomplishment. Our B Division Basketball and Football Teams emerged top 8 in East Zone and qualified for National League 1 respectively. The uniform groups (NCC, NCDCC, NPCC) were all recognised as "Distinction" units. Such accomplishment would be impossible without the passion and grit of teachers and students. The National School Games for C-Division teams are on-going. The school rallies behind every team and player, wishing them excellence.



Overseas Learning Journey to Penang

The trip took place from 21 to 25 May 2023. 26 students and 4 teachers embarked on the trip to broaden their knowledge of emerging educational, technological and economic trends in the region. They interacted with staff and students from Penang's SMK Convent Butterworth. Through this trip, students deepen their cross-cultural skills and strengthened their sense of belonging to Singapore.



Authentic Learning and Holistic

Development

Relatability of knowledge and skills acquired from the classroom is key to developing students' joy of learning. As such, the school has dedicated an authentic learning week to the STEAM Carnival featuring inter-disciplinary work including Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics from 15 - 18 May. The English Language and Literature Festival was held from 9 - 12 May as well where students attended author workshops and talks by professionals and went on learning journeys to learn how to unlock the power of language to make a difference. In the final week of Term 2, Sec 2 students embarked on a National Education/ Humanities Learning Journey to various World War 2 sites to appreciate the importance of national security and historical perspective taking. Sec 1 students picked up "future-skills" by participating the Code for Fun programme. Sec 3 students furthered their outdoor education through the 5-days MOE-OBS programme in March.



Update on Management of C+/Ag+

Students in school

In alignment with Singapore's endemic COVID-19 new norm, MOE has refined the guidelines for the management of C+/Ag+ students in school, where the focus is on individual's health and well-being and in developing students' social responsibility within the school community.

For students who are unwell, they should seek medical attention and/or stay home to rest (regardless of ART result)

For students who are well, they can return to school (regardless of ART result). if students has mild symptoms or test Ag+ but has no symptoms, the student should exercise social responsibility - minimise close physical contact with others in large group settings, and wear masks.

Attendance and Temperature Taking

Exercise

The attendance and temperature taking exercise for Term 3 will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **5 July 2023** for all staff and students. As 5 July is a Blended Learning Day, students attending from home will go through the exercise with their Home Teachers via the online platform. The exercise allows schools to maintain their preparedness to re-activate the attendance and temperature taking regime should the need arise. It will also help to educate students on taking personal responsibility for their own health and social responsibility.

Emergency Exercise

School Emergency Exercise

Our school will be conducting an Emergency Exercise on Friday, 4 Aug 2023 from 9.00am to 11.00am. This emergency exercise aims to train staff and students to be prepared for security incidents that may arise in the school and to be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures. During this exercise, we will have a lockdown drill followed by evacuation to an external holding site, which is Yumin Primary School. The evacuation will involve the students walking to the Yumin Primary School, assembling in the school hall, and then walking back to school. We seek your understanding that the school may not be able to attend to visitors during the period of exercise as all the staff will be involved in the exercise.



Travel Declaration for Sep Holidays

There would not be any reminders on travel declaration for short holidays (Mar/Sep). For the Sep school holidays, parents/guardians are to make a travel declaration for your child/ward only if he/she intends to travel overseas. There is no need to submit the form if your child is not travelling. If there is a change of travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration to update the travel plan via PG or inform the school of cancellation of travel plan(s).
